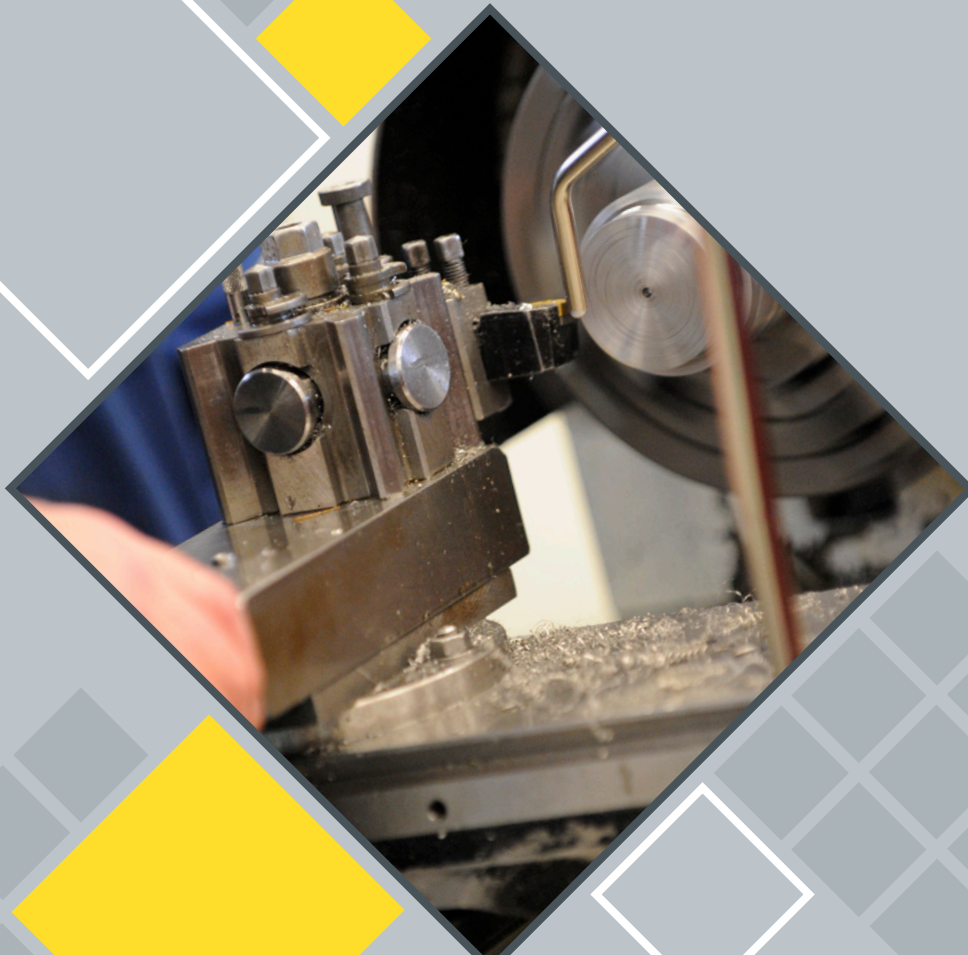


LEVEL 2 DIPLOMA PERFORMING MANUFACTURING OPERATIONS



> INTRODUCTION TO THE NEW QUALIFICATION

The NVQ Diploma in Performing Manufacturing Operations has been designed to help you become more effective in your role and give you credit for the skills and knowledge that you already possess.

> LEARNING AND ASSESSMENT

All of the training and assessment for this qualification will be carried out in the workplace to minimise disruption to business operations. Tutors will work with employers to make sure that visits take place at a convenient time. During the programme, you will complete a portfolio which will be formally assessed to prove you have the skills and knowledge for the Diploma to be awarded.

> ENTRY QUALIFICATION

You do not need any prior qualifications to do an NVQ. You need to be employed in manufacturing and seeking recognition of your skills and experience within your existing role or to enable career progression.

> COURSE DURATION

We would anticipate that a Level 2 NVQ to take no longer than 6 months.

TRAINING UNIT OPTIONS FOR LEVEL 2 DIPLOMA PERFORMING MANUFACTURING OPERATIONS

You are required to complete six units in total - 2 mandatory units plus 3 optional units from Supporting the Operation and one Job Specific Unit. 48 credits must be achieved.
