



LEVEL 3 DIPLOMA YOUTH WORK



> ENTRY QUALIFICATIONS

Level 3 is a qualification designed for people who often work as a Youth Support Worker. You might be leading on some projects with some degree of responsibility or independence. You will be responsible for working with young people to plan and evaluate sessions. You can be paid or voluntary.

> COURSE CONTENT

Total credits required to complete the qualification. **44**

- ▶ Understanding Youth Work Principles and Practice **(10 credits)**
- ▶ Understanding Principles, Knowledge and Skills in Work-Based Practice in Youth Work **(7 credits)**
- ▶ Understanding Intervention Strategies in Youth Work Settings **(6 credits)**
- ▶ Work-Based Practice in Youth Work **(9 credits)**

The remaining 12 credits come from the option units.

Unit certification can be claimed for all achieved units.

> COURSE DURATION

It is anticipated candidates complete within 9 months.

> COURSE FORMAT

You will be observed in the workplace by an assessor. Workshops can be arranged to support the learning during the day or the evening.

> COURSE COST

Please contact the college for an up to date cost of the course, this changes according to funding available. First Level 3 qualifications for people aged 19-24 are usually free.
