

## **Beauty Therapy- Level 2**

### **What will the Apprentice study?**

They will be working towards an NVQ level 2.

An NVQ (National Vocational Qualification) is a 'hands on' qualification that shows that you have the practical skills to do the job. Finally, the Apprentice may have to study Maths and/or English (Key Skills), dependant upon their GCSE results.

### **Entry Requirements**

Ideally, the Apprentice will have achieved GCSE's at Grade C or above in Maths and English.

### **Course Content**

The main qualification is the **City & Guilds NVQ2 in Beauty Therapy** gained in the workplace. The Apprentice will build a portfolio of proof of evidence which will include written information about the learner's ability. It will also include direct observation and practical questioning.

On their day release they will be studying the **City & Guilds Level 2: Beauty Therapy** which is made up of the following:

### **Units Practical Assessments**

Health & Safety For all Units

Fulfil salon reception duties

Develop & maintain effective team relations

Develop & Maintain positive working relationships with customers

Improve Facial skin conditions

Enhance the appearance of the eyebrows, eyelash Perming

Remove and lighten hair using temporary methods

Improve the appearance and conditions of the nails during Manicure

Improve the appearance and conditions of the nails during Pedicure

Each unit has a multi choice test paper and to complete the full qualification they must pass an on-line examination.

### **Course Duration and Format**

Normally 1 years, dependant on prior knowledge and experience. The Apprentice will spend 4 days in the workplace and attend College 1 day per week.

### **What support is available during the training?**

A member of Tameside College Training will provide support and guidance throughout and will also visit both you and your Apprentice in the workplace every 8 weeks.

### **How do I apply for free training?**

### **How much do I need to pay the Apprentice?**

There is no set standard for wages. Levels of pay will vary depending on the type of job and how much experience the Apprentice already has. However, you will be expected to pay at least £95.00 per week.

### **Progression**

The Apprentice can progress onto an Advanced Apprenticeship at Level 3
