The ILM level 2 NVQ in team Leading is designed for Team leader who are primarily concerned with motivating their team members and achieving agreed outputs, with limited authority for deploying resources. Flexibility is achieved through optional units which complement the four mandatory units designed to develop the core competences needed by today's team leaders.

Course Content

Candidates are required to take **six units: four mandatory units plus two** from a choice of the five **optional units**.

Mandatory units (four)

A1 Manage your own resources

B5 Provide Leadership for your team

D1 Develop productive working relationships with colleagues

E5 Ensure your own actions reduce risks to health and safety **

Optional units (select two)

C1 Encourage innovation in your team

D5 Allocate and check work

D7 Provide learning opportunities for colleagues

F5 Resolve customer service problems*

F7 support customer service improvements*

Qualification

ILM Level 2 in Team Leading

Entry Qualifications

Participants must be employed in a managerial role.

Progression

Candidates can progress onto ILM L3 in Management

Course Duration

Participants who are already competent and who are able to collect and present evidence without too much difficulty, may well complete the qualification within about three months. Others, who need to undertake some development activity and then apply their learning in the workplace to demonstrate competence, may find that they need up to 9 months.

Assessment

Assessment of the Team leading NVQs is by candidates providing evidence, normally through a portfolio and/or professional discussion, to demonstrate that they meet all of the requirements as described in the relevant standards. Each participant will be assigned an assessor who will help them identify and present evidence, and prepare them for assessment.
