

NVQ Level 2 Food & Drink Manufacturing

Who is the programme for?

The aim of this course is to enable staff to demonstrate their current capabilities and provide opportunities to develop their levels of expertise.

What is the course content?

A flexible syllabus to enable training to be tailored to meet specific needs. It will allow employees to become highly skilled and adaptable in their working practices and highly motivated in their approach to work. There are ten units to complete; the mandatory units cover generic aspects of the role such as Health & Safety and teamwork whereas the optional units can be tailored to meet the needs of your organisation.

Learning and Assessment

An assessor will visit candidates in their workplace to train, assess and review them on a regular basis. For groups of candidates from the same employer, knowledge workshops can be provided. For individuals this will be covered by your assessor during 1:1 appointments.

Entry Qualifications?

No formal qualifications are necessary though you will need to demonstrate that you have the necessary enthusiasm and commitment to successfully complete the course and you must already be working in the food and drink manufacturing sector.

Duration

The length of the course will vary according to workplace and individual, although there is an expectation that it will be completed within 6 months maximum.

How it all works

Candidates will study the following compulsory units:

- Contribute to health and safety in food and drink manufacturing operations
- Maintain hygiene standards in food and drink manufacturing operations
- Work with others in a food and drink manufacturing environment
- Diagnose and rectify operating problems
- Maintain product quality

There are a further 30 optional units from which the candidate chooses 5. These units include:

- Prepare for and carry out product changeovers
- Contribute to environmental safety in food and drink manufacturing operations
- Control mixing
- Produce individual packs
- Assemble different products to pre-determined pattern
- Collate and pack for storage and distribution

The course is delivered through a combination of open learning materials and workplace tutorial visits. Students will be assessed through the completion of work books and practical observations.
